

We need a constitutional amendment to protect marriage in Maine!

Natural Marriage is Under Attack. There is a nationwide effort to overturn state Defense of Marriage Act (DOMA) laws which define marriage as the union of one man and one woman.

The first step is very simple and straightforward. The process for amending Maine ’s constitution begins with the legislature. It requires a 2/3 vote by the House and Senate before it goes to the people. The best way to convince the legislature is by having individual legislators/candidates hear from their constituents. Concerned citizens of Maine will have to contact legislative candidates in their home districts to express their support for an amendment.

There is no petition to sign. There is no ballot for you to mark.

But you can help safeguard the definition of marriage for your children and your grandchildren by contacting a few candidates close to home.

This is not a debate about discrimination, “gay rights” or the separation of church and state. It is about thousands of years of common tradition and common sense for society. It is time for us to decide if we will speak up in agreement with God’s design for marriage, family and society. The issue is marriage.

This is your time.

It is your opportunity to make a difference.
Don’t leave it to others.
